## Caney Valley Public Schools Student Technology Insurance Program Grades 6th - 12th

The Caney Valley Public Schools Student Technology Insurance Program has been established to give parents the ability to purchase insurance for the 1:1 Instructional Technology Package for the 2021-2022 school year. The technology package includes a Chromebook and a protective carrying case. The insurance, if purchased, will cover the repair or replacement costs of everything except the charging cord. The cost of protection during the 2021-2022 school year is \$30 per student. This is a voluntary program and families are strongly encouraged but not required to participate.

Acts of intentional damage or signs that the Chromebook was not regularly carried in the district-issued case, will not be covered by the insurance.

Keep in mind, according to the <u>Responsible Use Agreement</u>, <u>parents are responsible</u> for the full cost of any repair or replacement of all damage to or loss of the Chromebook, charger or case.

## Insurance Coverage:

If purchased, the CVS Student Technology Insurance covers 100% of the **FIRST** incident of damage or loss (including theft\*\*) of the Technology Package Items (Chromebook and case), **50%** of the **SECOND** incident of damage or loss (including theft\*\*) of the Technology Package Items from the Date of the issue through checking in the device at the end of the school year in May **2021.** After **two incidents**, the parent is responsible for **all** repairs and replacement costs. \***Exact repair/replacement costs will be determined at the time of the repair.**

Parents will have the opportunity to purchase insurance during the Continuing Enrollment process OR at Schedule Pickup by check or cash.

If purchasing insurance, it must be purchased at the scheduled pick up BEFORE student takes possession of the Technology Package.
